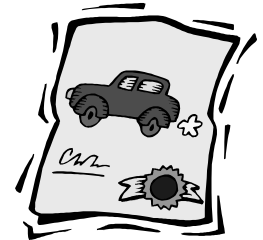
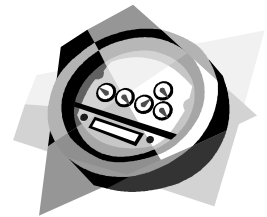


I Own a Car, or Does it Own Me?
